

ASH WEDNESDAY—FEBRUARY 14, 2018

"Jesus full of the Holy Spirit returned from the Jordan and was led by the Spirit in the wilderness, where for 40 days he was tempted by the devil." Luke 4:1-2a

Ash Wednesday begins the observance of **Lent** and is an invitation to embark on a profound spiritual journey. This Spirit filled journey leads us from death to new life lived through faith in the resurrection of Jesus Christ.

The day is named for the imposition of ashes. Using ashes as a sign of repentance is an ancient practice found in the Old Testament. Early Christians adopted the use of ashes from the covenant people, as an external mark of penitence.

Ashes are a reminder of God's condemnation of sin. As ashes are smeared on our forehead we hear the same words spoken to Adam and Eve, "Dust you are and to dust you shall return." Ashes suggest cleansing and renewal. Used in the absence of soap, they are a penitential substitute for water as a remembrance of baptism. Ashes are a reminder of the shortness of human life, and symbolic of the ongoing need to repent, confess sins, and return to God who is Holy in merciful love.

LENT-A JOURNEY TO THE CROSS

Lent is the opportunity to return to the foundation of faith, baptism. In Holy Baptism, sinners are freed from death in sin and reborn anew united with Jesus Christ. Music tones for worship facilitate reflection. Reflection and devotion upon the mystery of faith rooted in the cross where Christ's perfect sacrifice redeems mortals for new life; new life with purpose-to proclaim the good news of endless life reconciled through merciful love. The church's faithful practice of Lent is a testament to the Gospel. The disciple of Lent may not be easy or feel good however this is a precious gift of faith active in growing love for God.



LILLY ENDOWMENT - CLERGY RENEWAL PROGRAM GRANT

The vision of this parish is to faithfully grow ministries in each congregation for the sake of the Gospel. The Holy Spirit in a pastor and congregational leaders dedicated to mission together is crucial to our vision. The call to serve two congregations and the surrounding community is demanding. Pastor Jill has served for ten years and has requested extended time for rest, reflection and study. This actually is helpful to both congregations as well giving time to vision ministry with added resources. The Lilly Endowment Clergy Renewal grant

monies will pay entire cost for a three month leave including supply reimbursement and resources for congregational study. Grants approved by this foundation must clearly communicate that a process is mutually supported by both the clergy and congregations. All leaders of council agreed to form team to pursue grant funding for renewal. Team members are Jerry Droz, Paul Kamzelski, Mike Holcomb and Laura Strobel. This group has begun to pray together with Pastor. Additionally they will provide leadership in the process of grant writing, and communications with congregations. FROM THE PASTOR

Beloved of God,

The Holy Spirit never stops moving in the living body of Christ. Since 2008, steady progress has been made in reforming churches focused upon survival into churches poised for new growth.


